Synopsis (max. 12 pages)

Structure of the planned dissertation (max. 3 pages)

Timetable (timeline or in table form, max. 2 pages)

Separate summary of the research topic in German (max. 1 page)

Bibliography (max. 6 pages)

1st specialist review (thesis supervisor review, please note the reviewer and assessment criteria on the homepage)

2nd expert review (free choice, please note the expert and expert review criteria on the homepage)

CV in tabular form (max. 2 pages)

Formulated CV (running text, max. 3 pages)

Admission of the doctorate by the doctoral committee of the university

References

- Abitur certificate (graduation diploma, university entrance qualification)
- Bachelor's certificate including certificates of achievement and overall grade
- Master's certificate including certificates of achievement and overall grade
- or equivalent certificates including certificates of achievement and overall grade

informal reasons for

- a doctorate abroad (max. 1 page)
- Non-Protestant applicants (letter of motivation)
- Dissertation in English

Certificate for German language skills B2/DSH (only necessary for foreign applicants)
